Following is a summary of the meetings and deadlines scheduled over the next several weeks. Please ensure that the relevant people are informed and attend, as required.

The meetings noted below will be held in the Jury Hearing Room of the Antiguo Edificio Varadero.

### Declaration, Unveiling, & Registration of Yachts

<b>31 March</b>	<b>Saturday</b>	<b>1800</b>	Deadline for filing the Declaration of Yacht(s) in the office of the Regatta Director.
<b>1 April</b>	<b>Sunday</b>	<b>0930</b>	Unveiling of all ACC Yachts. Competitors will observe the schedule provided in the Unveiling Agreement.
<b>2 April</b>	<b>Monday</b>	<b>1405</b>	Deadline for Registration of the yacht to participate in Valencia Louis Vuitton Act 13.

### For Valencia Louis Vuitton Act 13:

**30 March Friday 0930 Skippers of the Team Chase Boat and Team Weather Boats**

Each Competitor is permitted to have one (1) Chase Boat and two (2) Weather Boats operating inside the Race Diamond at times specified in the Notice of Race. All skippers of each of these boats shall attend a meeting with the Race Committee as above.

At this meeting the Race Committee will issue Chase Boat Flags and the Safety Radio equipment.

**31 March Saturday 1900 Competitor's Meeting**

A representative of each Competitor shall attend a meeting with the Race Committee, Umpires, and Jury.

**2 April Monday 0900 Flag Meeting for Skippers of AC Management Photo, Media, & TV Boats**

The skipper of each of the above boats shall attend a meeting with the Race Committee and Course Marshals.

**2 April Monday 1000 Flag Meeting for Captains of *bona fide* Spectator Boats of Competitors and AC Management (including Foredeck, Goleta, and Press Boats).**

An authorized representative of each Competitor and the Captain of each vessel that a Competitor nominates to be flagged shall attend a meeting with the Course Marshals as above.

As per the Terms of Challenge, each Competitor is permitted to apply for up to three (3) Flags for its *bona fide* Spectator Boats.

The Captain and "pilot" of each spectator boat used or authorized by AC Management and a representative of AC Management shall also attend this meeting with the Course Marshals.

**For the Louis Vuitton Cup:**

**13 April Friday 0900 Flag Meeting for Skippers of AC Management Photo, Media, & TV Boats**

The skipper of each of the above boats shall attend a meeting with the Race Committee and Course Marshals.

**14 April Saturday 1900 Competitor's Meeting for Challengers**

A representative of each Challenger shall attend a meeting with the Race Committee, Umpires, and Jury.

**15 April Sunday 0930 Flag Meeting for Skippers of *bona fide* Spectator Boats of Competitors and AC Management (including Foredeck, Goleta, and Press Boats).**

An authorized representative of each Competitor and the Captain of each vessel that a Competitor nominates to be flagged shall attend a meeting with the Course Marshals as above.

As per the Terms of Challenge, each Competing Competitor (Challenger) is permitted to apply for up to three (3) Flags for its *bona fide* Spectator Boats.

The Captain and "pilot" of each spectator boat used or authorized by AC Management and a representative of AC Management shall also attend this meeting with the Course Marshals.

**Subsequent Meetings:**

Additional information will be provided at a later date for similar meetings to be held prior to the start of the Semi-finals and Finals of the Louis Vuitton Cup, and for the 32<sup>nd</sup> Match.
