Attached please find the Course Marshal Instructions and Flag Application for Acts 6 & 7.

Each vessel requesting or required to carry a flag shall file the Application with the Regatta Director. Applications may be sent electronically to dyer.jones@acregatta.org.

Only vessels approved by the Regatta Director will receive flags.

A series of meetings will be held on 24 August 2005 in the Jury Hearing Room of the Regatta Operations Office in the Malmö Högskola. Each meeting is for the Captains of a specific group of vessels. The purpose is to review the Course Marshal Instructions and to distribute the flags.

Attendance by the Captain of each vessel at the relevant meeting is compulsory. The Captain is the person who will be in command of the vessel each day that it is in or near the Flag Area of the Race Diamond. Please note that yacht managers, brokers, and charter agents are not substitutes.

Schedule of Flag Meetings on 24 August 2005

- 09.30 Captains of all AC Management Photo and Media RIB's.
- 10.30 Captains and Course Guides of all AC Management Foredeck Guest Boats;
Captains and Course Guides of the AC Management Media (Press) Boats;
Captains of the 3 AC Management Host Broadcast TV Boats; and
Pilots of AC Management Host Broadcast and accredited Photo Helicopters.
- 11.30 Captains of Competitor's *bona fide* Official Spectator Boats – limit of 3 boats
per Competitor (refer to Terms of Challenge Clause 16.2).
&
Captains of Sailing Region official and Medical Assistance boats.
- NB: Competitor Tender, Chase Boats, and Weather Boats do not need to attend
meetings on 24 August.
